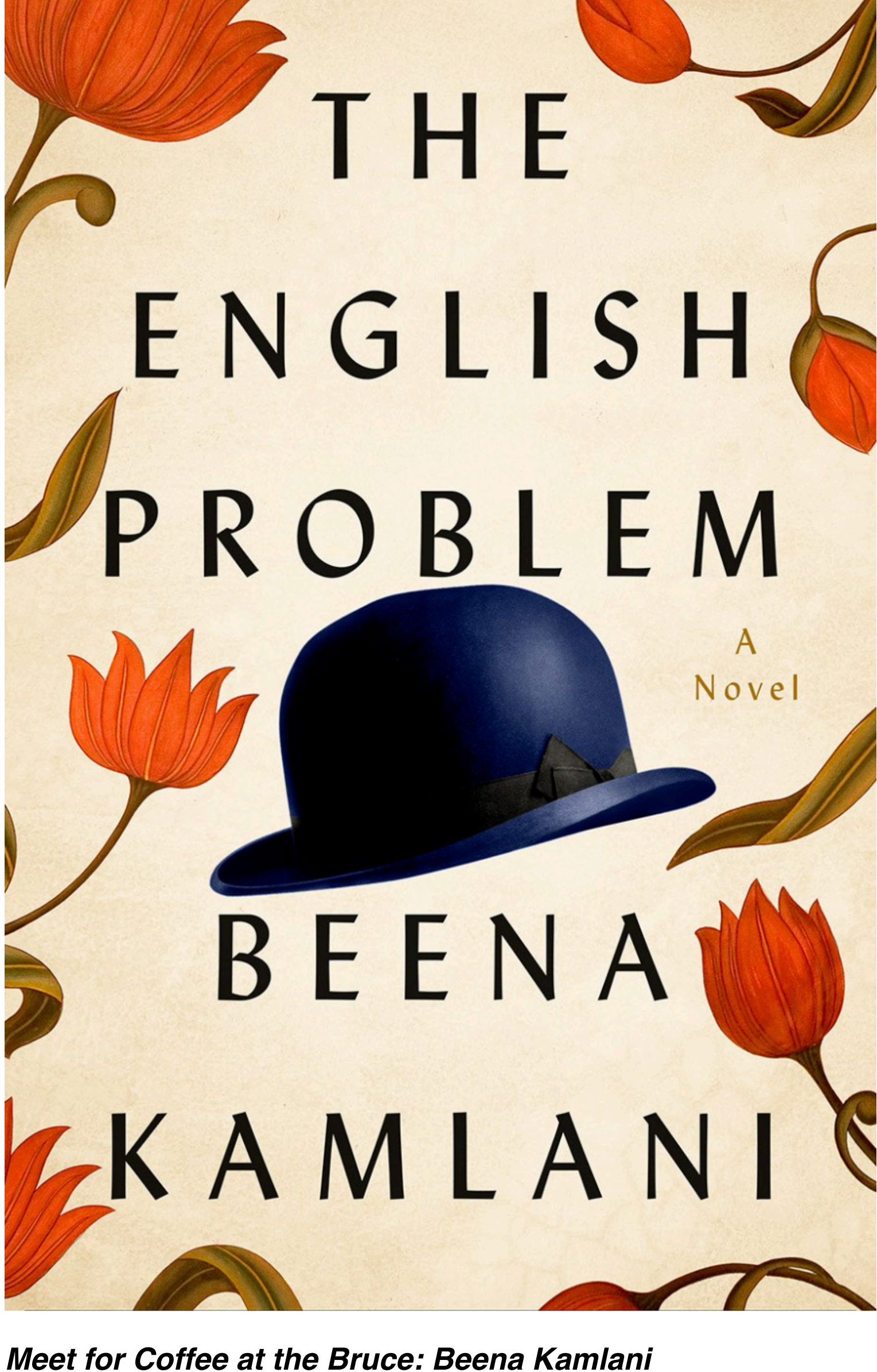

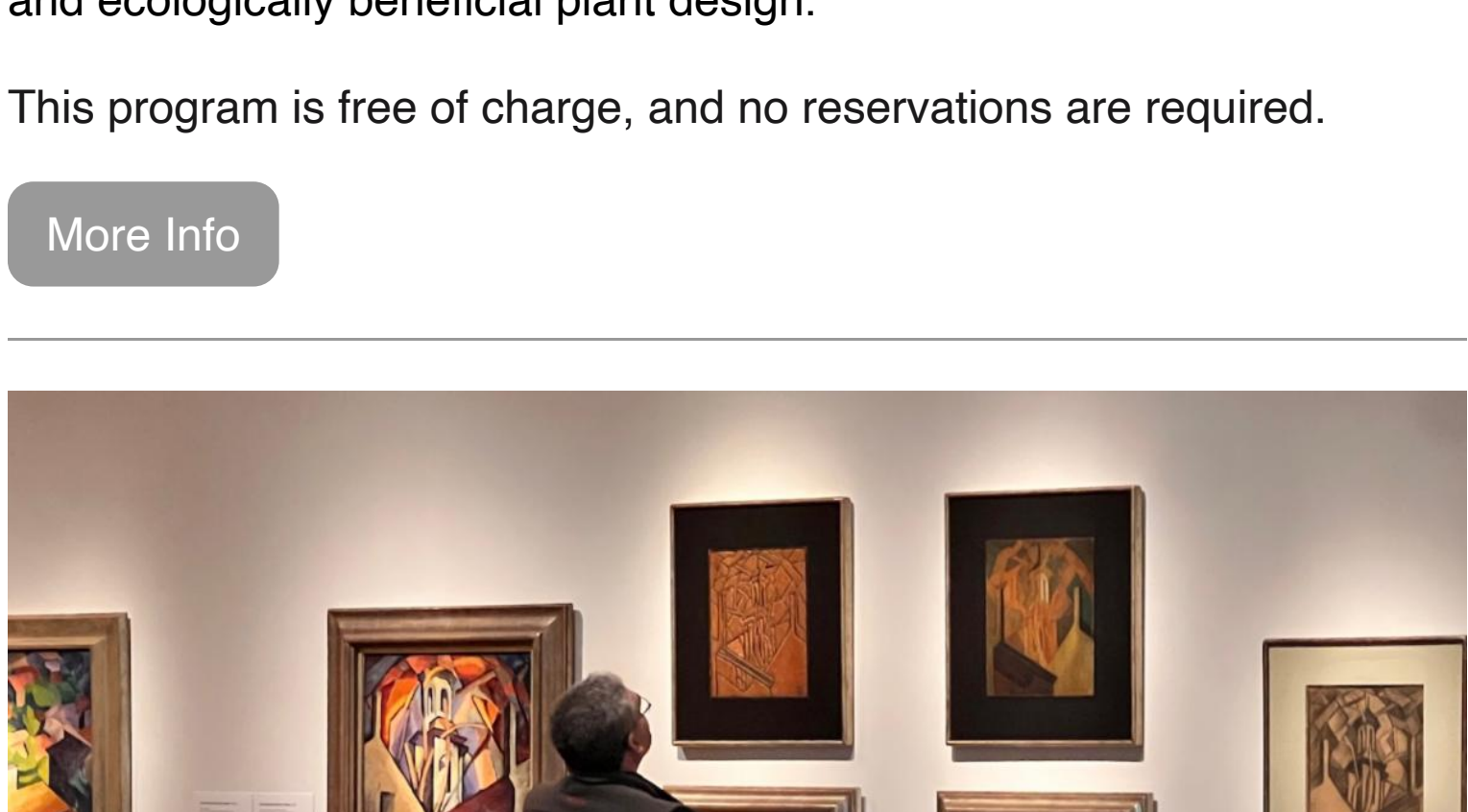


Fred Elser First Sunday Science: How to Cultivate a Green and Abundant Garden in Greenwich

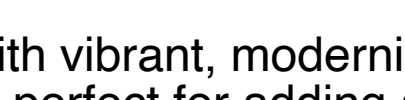
